

STM LICENCE FOR NON-COMMERCIAL RE-USE, INCLUDING TRANSLATION AND TEXT AND DATA MINING (“STM NONCOMTDM&T SL”) version 1.0

Agreeing to the Publisher’s licence enables the Licensee (“Researcher”) and any downstream user to:

Use the Work/Article anywhere in the world for non-commercial purposes, including by access, download, copy, display in any manner or form, redistribute, translate and transcribe in any language, “text and data mine” (see definition), abridge, describe the Work/Article provided that Licensee/users:

- Cite the Work/Article using an appropriate bibliographic citation, eg authors, book/journal, article title/chapter title, volume, issue, page numbers, DOI and the link to the definitive published version.
- Use the article for non- commercial purposes only.
- Maintain the integrity of the Work/Article.
- Retain copyright notices and links to these terms and conditions so it is clear to other users what can and cannot be done with the Work/Article.
- Ensure that, for any content in the Work/Article that is identified as belonging to a third party, any re-use complies with the copyright policies of that third party.

By way of indication, “commercial purposes” include:

- Copying or downloading articles, or linking to such postings, for further redistribution, sale or licensing, for a fee;
 - Copying, downloading or posting by a site or service that incorporates advertising with such content;
 - The inclusion or incorporation of article content in other works or services (other than normal quotations with an appropriate citation) that is then available for sale or licensing, for a fee;
 - Use of articles or article content (other than normal quotations with appropriate citation) by for-profit organizations for promotional purposes, whether for a fee or otherwise;
 - Use for the purposes of monetary reward by means of sale, resale, license, loan, transfer or other form of commercial exploitation.

- “text and data minig” as used herein means loading and technically format the Work/Licensed Material on the Licensee’s server using automated programs or devices to download, index extract semantic entities, derive patterns and for the Licensee to evaluate and interpret any TDM Output (“TDM Output” means the result of any Text and Data Mining activity or operation, capable of fixation, reproduction and/or communication in any form) for access and use by Licensee, but without creating Adapted Material, product or service that competes with the Work/Licensed Material.
