- Society membership






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One-Size-Fits-One Communication

- Have everything in one place



Practical:

Delivery:

- Finding the right vendors/building in-house expertise
- Aligning delivery across agile teams
- Developing integrations with live systems



Where We Are



- Still relatively early days
- Submission front-end: microservice hub live and rolling out
- Pricing decision service: MVP launching soon
- Licensing decision service: exists, but built pre-microservice architecture
